Anyone within your group with any medical conditions, physical limitations, is seriously overweight, **PREGNANT or presumed to be pregnant should consult a physician prior to any river trip.** All participants are required to sign a release and indemnity agreement and acknowledgment and assumption of risk form.

We operate under special use permits from the White River National Forest, USDA Forest Service, BLM and the Colorado Department of Parks. All KODI trips are subject to a land and water use fee. KODI Rafting is an equal opportunity service provider. Colorado River Outfitter License #0565. Due to changes in water flows and conditions, trip difficulty, classification, and minimum ages may vary from day-to-day. Children's prices are for ages 12 and under.

ARKANSAS RIVER – Buena Vista

Browns Canyon Full & Half Day

Experience rafting on the Arkansas River at its best. This Class III trip is ideal for the first time boater or the veteran paddler, combining the perfect mix of whitewater, calm water and majestic scenery.

Minimum age: 7
Full Day: Departs the Arkansas River Outpost at 9:30 a.m.

A classic Browns Canyon Half Day with a twist! Take on the rapids in a 9-foot raft with 3 boaters (including the guide).

Numbers Full & Half Day

A continuous ride through the upper portion of the Arkansas River. This is a class IV trip that is not for the faint of heart. Take on the experience of 7 major rapids in a short 7 river miles with plenty of fun to be had in between!

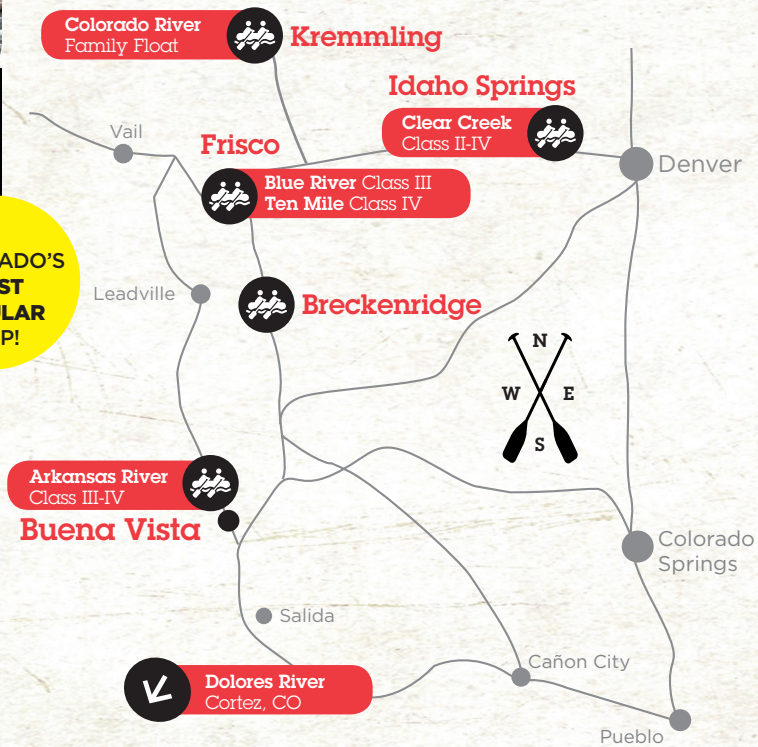
Arkansas River Experience Full Day

Colorado River Full & Half Day

Just downstream of the headwaters of the mighty Colorado River, this Class I-II mild water float is gentle and perfect for all ages. This is a great trip for families with youngsters, or those just looking for a relaxing trip along a remote and scenic stretch of river with historic cabins and natural hot springs.

Minimum age: 4 or 40lbs

Full Day: Departs our Colorado River Outpost at 9:15 a.m. **Adults \$102 / Children \$92** (12 and under) (includes lunch)
Half Day: Departs our Colorado River Outpost at 9:15 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. **Adults \$67 / Children \$59** (12 and under)



Inflatable Kayak Duckies

Experience the thrill of your own boat in these very stable kayaks. A guided trip follows our rafting trips down the river.

Minimum age: 14

Full Day: Departs our Colorado River Outpost at 9:15 a.m. **Adults \$109** (includes lunch)

Stand-Up Paddle Boarding Full Day

Our Stand-Up Paddle boarding (SUP) trip is designed for groups of up to six. SUP trips begin with a flat-water training session and a paddle down the Upper Colorado River for a riverside lunch. After lunch our professional guides will lead you down a beautiful Class I-II stretch of river on your SUP. Another guide will be on the trip in a raft.

Minimum age: 14

Full Day: Departs from our Colorado River Outpost 10:00 a.m. **Adults \$156** (includes full gear rental, transportation from outpost and lunch)



BLUE RIVER - FRISCO

Blue River Half Day

This is a short trip with plenty of fun and scenery. The Blue River starts with 3 miles of fairly tame water. Then you'll turn the corner into Boulder Canyon where you'll be smiling big as you enjoy 3 miles of majestic Class II-III whitewater to the finish.

Minimum age: 7

TEN MILE CREEK - FRISCO

Ten Mile Half Day

The newest commercially run river in Colorado, this is an intense four mile, Class IV run not for the faint of heart. After floating through the town of Frisco we'll finish up at the Frisco Bay Marina on Lake Dillon. All participants must be in good physical condition and have previous rafting experience.

Minimum age: 16

CLEAR CREEK - Idaho Springs

Beginner 1/3 Day

Great for families and beginner boaters alike, this trip takes you back in time through the historic mining town of Idaho Springs. A great Class II-III trip with a convenient location in Idaho Springs.

Minimum age: 7

Departs our Clear Creek Outpost at 9:00 a.m. or 3:00 p.m. **Adults \$54 / Children \$49** (12 and under) - wetsuits included

Intermediate Half Day

Start with a warm up of Class II water before cascading through the steep and technical rapids of Clear Creek. Guests enjoy a pool drop Class III-IV experience before floating to the finish with some more Class II-III.

Minimum age: 14

Departs our Clear Creek Outpost at 12:00 p.m. or 3:00 p.m. **Adults \$64** - wetsuits included

Advanced Half Day

An action-packed whitewater trip for the experienced paddler or those with a true sense of adventure. Tight, steep and technical are the three best words we like to use to describe this trip.

Minimum age: 16

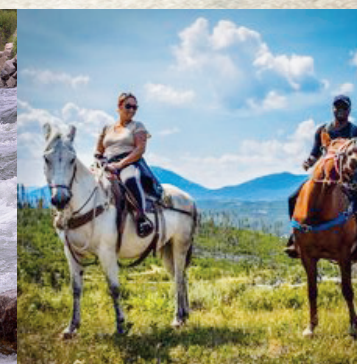
